5. Emotional Stability

How do you handle stress?

How do you handle conflict?

How do you handle minor setbacks?

Do you ask for help when you need it?

6. Personal Follow-through

If you are accepted to Northpoint, what is the likelihood of completion, barring any extreme circumstances?

7. Spiritual/Ethical
