\_\_\_\_\_ Unaccredited Bible college. Various Bible/Christian institutions offer undergraduate bachelor's degrees that are reasonably academically rigorous but are unaccredited. An example of this might be a Bible college that is in the process of pursuing accreditation. In such cases where the unaccredited degree equals 90 credits or more toward an accredited bachelor's degree, the student may be accepted into a Northpoint graduate program. For example, if a student graduates from an institute with 120 credits earned, that may be enough to satisfy

the 90-credit mark if the courses required enough hours in the classroom per semester.

Such institutes may award completion certificates but do not confer college degrees. Credits awarded will typically count toward credit at a ratio of two earned to one awarded. The number of classroom hours should be considered in the ratio. Credits awarded will be decreased if the institutional credits did not meet the minimal hours for college credit (15 hours per credit per semester).

Life Experience for Advanced Standing. See the undergraduate policy for granting up to 17 credits for life experience. Students may provide a resume or similar document demonstrating life experiences. Certificates, references, and/or similar documentation should accompany the resume.

1. The applicant for life experience credit must have a minimum of ten years of full-time ministry experience before his or her first semester begins at Northpoint. For the internship courses, five years of formal, full-time ministry as an adult are required.
2. The applicant must demonstrate with substantial documentation that his or her ministry experience constitutes sufficient experience to fulfill the requirement of the course for which credit is desired.
