This letter may be used as evidence that in accordance with Public Act 327 of 1931, as amended, MCL 450.170-177, our office confirms that Zion Bible College, has demonstrated that: (a) the housing space and administrative facilities that it possesses or proposes to provide for its declared field or fields of education are adequate; (b) its proposed educational program leading to the diplomas or degrees that it proposes to offer is adequate; (c) the laboratory, library, and other teaching facilities that it possesses or proposes to provide are adequate; (d) it has or proposes to employ an adequate staff, fully trained, for the instruction proposed; and (e) at least 50% of its capital, whether consisting of stock or in gifts, devises, legacies, bequests or other contributions of money or property, has been paid in or is in its possession.
